

EAGLE WORLDWIDE RETREAT & REVIVAL CENTRE

2017 RULES and REGULATIONS

1. This property is for ministry services and functions ONLY and is not open for public or recreational use.
2. No one is permitted to stay on the grounds without registering with Eagle Worldwide Retreat and Revival Centre. Accommodations are only available during "camp season" (July 9th, 2017 - September 3rd, 2017).
3. No one under the age of 18 years is permitted to stay on the grounds without a parent or legal guardian present or express written permission by a parent or legal guardian. All those under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an appropriate legal guardian or caretaker while on the campground and must have prior approval from the Eagle Worldwide office to stay on the grounds.
4. No smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages permitted.
5. No swimming in either lake.
6. No boating or fishing without permission.
7. No pets allowed except by permission. Permitted pets must be kept on a leash and you must clean up after them. If barking is a problem you may be asked to remove the animal or leave the campground.
8. Campfires are allowed at the discretion of the Retreat Centre management and only in designated/controlled areas and must be put out by midnight.
9. No removal and cutting of wood. Guests may pick up sticks or obtain firewood as supplied by the camp. Cutting of live trees imposes a fine of \$100.00 for the cost of replacing the tree.
10. No noise after 11:00 pm; No excessive noise or disturbances at any time.
11. Guests must leave the camp by 11:00pm or 30 minutes after the completion of the service, or register as an overnight guest.
12. Guests must not remove or damage any property, including picnic tables. A fine of \$100.00 to replace the damaged table(s) will be charged.
13. For your protection, DO NOT leave coolers, bikes or other valuables unsecured. Eagle Worldwide Ministries is NOT responsible for any missing, lost, stolen or damaged items.
14. Only 2 cars are allowed on one site per family.
15. Speed limit at all times is 15 Km/h.
16. **Do not leave your children unattended.** There will be children's ministry provided only on selected evenings. There are obvious natural hazards such as the lakes that you need to be careful of and use wisdom in these environments. All children must be kept in the tent during the night-time meetings.
17. It is your responsibility to keep your site/cottage neat and in order. Please keep all sites free of clutter, debris and garbage. Our goal is to keep the Ministry campground visually enjoyable to all our guests. We appreciate your help in assisting us to keep our campgrounds clean. There is a garbage bin near the entrance to the camp.
18. Victoria or Reid Grassick will select and assign your campsite/cottage. Please do not use any site that has not been assigned to you. Victoria or Reid will also do site inspection at check out. All personal items must be removed and the site/cottage thoroughly cleaned prior to your leaving.
19. Eagle Worldwide and or staff and volunteers are not responsible for any damages caused by any negligence either physical or to personal property.
20. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations may mean dismissal from the Retreat Centre.
